Name of Awarding Institution: The University of Newcastle, Australia
Name of Scholarship: Academic Merit Scholarships
Name(s) of Course(s): Bachelor of Business, Bachelor of Commerce, Bachelor of Economics, Bachelor of Finance or Bachelor of Management.

Details of Scholarship:

- **Full or Partial Scholarship** Partial - 25% and 50% tuition fees scholarships for full duration of program
- **Duration of Scholarship:** Program duration (3 years)
- **Scholarship Coverage:** Tuition Fees only
- **Offer Period of Scholarship:** To be offered for commencement in July 2007
- **Estimated Value of Scholarship:** in RM / AUD
Scholarship values will vary depending on the applicant's individual merit – ranging from 25% to 50% of program fees, ie, up to AUD23 280 (approx MYR 65 000)
- **Eligibility**
 1. Students must meet the (1) academic and (2) English proficiency requirements of the nominated program.
 2. The scholarship offer is also available for students seeking advanced standing or credit transfers.
- **Application Process**

 - a. The scholarship offer is only for the nominated program;
 - b. Satisfactory progress in the nominated academic degree program must be maintained.
- **Final Date for Submission:** 31 May 2007 for Semester 2, 2007 intake
